At the outset, the Chairman, Senate welcomed all members and initiated discussion on the agenda item. The following decision was taken.


S-60/19/1: To consider request of 2016 Batch B.Tech. students to conduct a special exam

As permitted by the Chairman, Senate, two student representatives from 2016 batch (Rohit Kashyap & Partha Pratim Kashyap) were allowed to present their views. Further, the Senate also noted the comment of Prof. B.K. Roy, one of the Senate members, read out by the Chairman, Senate during the meeting.

After detailed discussion on the matter and based on the majority opinion, the Senate resolved to allow the 2016 batch B.Tech. students to appear the special exam scheduled during 19 Aug to 23 Aug 2019. However, they shall be allowed to register a maximum of three backlog subjects (theory only). Students who have already registered the backlog subject(s) for the current odd semester (July-Dec 2019 session) and willing to register the same subject(s) in the special exam can do so, but the registration of the concerned subject(s) in the current odd semester, if any, shall be treated cancelled.¹

The Senate confirmed the aforesaid decision on the table.
